16.1 Setting the Budget and Precept for 2019/20

The Parish Council will set the budget for 2019/20. Anticipated payments will be offset by anticipated receipts to give a budget balance which the PC will use to decide the precept request.

The Council will be asked to RESOLVE:-

That a budget is set based on anticipated levels of income and expenditure on items from 2018/9 that need to be continued; items that are to be discontinued and on new items.

- (a) That a budget of (to be agreed at the meeting) be approved;
- (b) That the Clerk be authorised to request a precept of (to be agreed at the meeting) from Cheshire East Council

(Cheshire East Council fixed its Taxbase for the financial year 2019/20 by Resolution of the Council on the 13th December 2018. The Taxbase for Bunbury Parish Council area is 627.81compared to a current amount of 632.34. As an indication, if the current Band D Council Tax (of £33.21) remained the same, this would reduce the precept from £21,000 to £20,850. Alternatively, if the precept remained at £21,000 then the Band D Council Tax would increase to £33.45 when using the new taxbase. Increasing the precept would increase the Council Tax proportionally. An adjustment factor of 99.00% is already included to calculate the taxbase figure to allow for potential losses on collection).
